HOMEcomings 2006 TRAFFIC ADVISORY

IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ THIS NOTICE AS IT CONCERNS ALL TRAFFIC IN AND OUT OF THE CAMPUS ON OCTOBER 20.

On the afternoon of Friday, October 20, 2006, traffic flow on the four main streets surrounding the campus will be altered to accommodate the University of Memphis Homecoming Parade and pep rally. Central Avenue, Patterson Street, Walker Avenue, and Zach Curlin Street will all be affected; however, Central Avenue will remain open during the entire event.

Beginning at 4:00 p.m., no traffic will be permitted to enter the campus by way of Zach Curlin, where the parade will form. Anyone attending a class or event on the south and east sides of the campus should enter by way of Walker; they will have access to the garage and parking lots along Zach Curlin. You will be able to leave campus by way of Walker until 5:00 p.m.

The parade will begin at 5:30 p.m. and should last approximately forty-five minutes. The parade will travel south on Zach Curlin, west on Walker, north on Patterson, and east on Central to Innovation Drive, where the parade will end. Access to and from the garage on Innovation Drive will be restricted as the parade is ending. The pep rally will take place on the southeast corner of Central and Patterson next to the Fogelman College of Business.

The Memphis Police Department will control traffic on all city streets and at all city street intersections. The University Police will direct traffic where the campus streets and parking lot driveways intersect with city streets.

During the parade, the city streets and campus streets/drives will be closed and re-opened incrementally and progressively (e.g., Patterson will still be open to traffic at the beginning of the parade). Each street allowing access to the campus will be re-opened to traffic after the parade has completely cleared that street. Patterson between Norriswood and Central will remain closed to vehicular traffic until after the conclusion the pep rally.

Once the parade begins, access to any street along the parade route should be restricted for no more than 15 minutes. University police officers will assist anyone attempting to leave campus during the parade if an alternate route is available. However, we strongly encourage those who need to leave campus that afternoon to do so before 5:00 p.m.

Anyone arriving at the campus for Homecoming and other campus events will be able to enter the Central Lot and park. Once Zach Curlin and Walker are re-opened around 6:10 p.m., visitors will be able to park in the Zach Curlin lots and in the Zach Curlin Garage. If you know if anyone coming to campus for Homecoming or any other event, please forward this information to them.

This message is being sent to allow the entire campus community to plan their activities in conjunction with the parade and pep rally.
