

LT COL JERRY P. BRUMFIELD

Lt Col Jerry Brumfield is the Commander and Professor of Aerospace Studies, Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps (AFROTC) Detachment 785 at the University of Memphis, in Memphis, Tennessee. He is responsible for recruiting, educating, training, motivating, and commissioning officer candidates through a comprehensive college program.

Lt Col Brumfield graduated from Louisiana State University in 1987, entered the Air Force in 1989, and received his commission from Officer Training School at Medina Annex, Lackland Air Force Base, Texas. Lt Col Brumfield is a career missileer who has served as a missile combat crew member at Francis E. Warren AFB Wyoming and has taught ICBM operations at the 392nd Training Squadron at Vandenberg AFB California. He completed two tours at Cape Canaveral AFS Florida as a Titan IV crew member and as the Chief of Standardization and Evaluation sandwiched by a tour at the Air Force Personnel Center where he was the Chief of Missile and Space Officer Assignments.

Following Lt Col Brumfield's second assignment to Cape Canaveral he attended Air Command and Staff College (ACSC) at Maxwell AFB Alabama. He remained on faculty at ACSC post graduation serving there until taking command of Detachment 785 in July 2008.
