



The University of Memphis Alumni Association Scholarship Program

The University of Memphis Alumni Association announces the availability of three \$4,000 Alumni Scholarships for first time freshmen entering the University of Memphis in the Fall 2009 semester. The Alumni Scholars Program encourages family members of the University of Memphis's alumni to make the U of M their first choice for higher education. It is designed to build unity and tradition among the U of M family by producing a legacy for relatives of alumni.

The Scholarship

The award is a four-year scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 per year (\$500 per semester). The initial award will be made only to first-time, incoming freshmen. The scholarship is renewable for each of the student's sophomore, junior and senior years without application, contingent upon the student being in good standing at the University of Memphis, making satisfactory progress towards a U of M undergraduate degree, and maintaining a full-time course load. The student must maintain a minimum overall grade point average of 2.5 for the first two semesters and 3.0 or higher each subsequent semester.

Eligibility

The applicant must be eligible for admission to the University of Memphis as a freshman without waiver, must be classified and enrolled at the University of Memphis in the Fall semester immediately following his/her high school graduation to receive this award.

The selection committee shall consider scholarship and leadership in making its selection. The committee shall determine the relative weight given to each criterion. There are no restrictions to applicants based on gender, race, nationality, country of origin, physical disability, veteran status, or gender orientation.

At least one family member of the applicant must be a dues-paying member of the University of Memphis Alumni Association as of the 2008 calendar year for the student to be eligible for this award. The family member must remain a dues-paying member of the Alumni Association for the length of time the student receives the scholarship.

Recipients of the award shall not forfeit other scholarships, grants, or awards to which they are entitled. However, if a recipient applies for financial aid, the amount of the award may be used in calculating the total amount of aid for which the student is eligible.

Instructions

1. Please type or complete the application form in ink. Complete each item.
2. Apply and be accepted for admission to the University of Memphis.
3. The application packet (including application, transcript(s) and letters of recommendation) must be received or postmarked by February 27, 2009.
4. Recipients will be notified by April 1, 2009.
5. Recipients must accept the Alumni Scholarship by May 1, 2009.
