Please announce the scholarship criteria to students. Application forms may be picked up in Rooms 212, office 106 and from PETE faculty.**

Criteria:

This scholarship is available to junior, senior or graduate level **female students** at the University of Memphis.

Undergraduate level applicants must meet the following requirements:

United States citizenship
Status as a full time student (12 credit hours)
Minimum GPA of 2.75
Declared major in the HSS Department with a desire to work with young people through teaching, coaching, sports leadership and/or athletic training

Graduate student applicants must meet the following requirements:

United States citizenship
Status as a full time student (9 credit hours)
Minimum GPA of 3.25
Declared major in the HSS Department with a desire to work with young people through teaching, coaching, sports leadership, and/or athletic training

Preference will be given to female student athletes participating in women's varsity or club sports **or to females majoring in physical education teacher education (PETE)**, provided that all of the above requirements are met.

Applicants for the scholarship must submit all materials by **March 31, 2009** to be eligible.

Two or more letters of recommendation, a resume, and a current transcript must be submitted to:
