<p align="center">Men's Ice Hockey Dead Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November 9-12, 2009, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 12-15, 2010, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 7-11 (noon), 2010, (Wednesday prior to the Division I Men's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the Sunday after the game).
<p align="center">Women's Ice Hockey Dead and Quiet Periods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November 9-12, 2009, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the fall signing of the National Letter of Intent) • March 18-22 (noon), 2010, (the day prior to the Division I Women's Ice Hockey Championship to noon on the day after the game). • April 12-15, 2010, (during the period Monday through Thursday of the initial week for the spring signing of the National Letter of Intent). • April 26 through May 31 2010, is considered a quiet period.
