



Acting as a prospective student-athlete (PSA) host is an important service to the institution and the department of athletics. Appropriate conduct is required of you by institutional, conference and NCAA standards.

As a PSA host or hostess YOU: _____

- must be enrolled at this institution
- may receive a free meal in conjunction with hosting a prospective student-athlete
- may be provided maximum of \$30 per day to provide entertainment for a prospective student athlete and his/her parents (legal guardians) or spouse
- may only entertain a PSA within a 30-mile radius of campus
- may receive a complimentary admission (no hard tickets) when accompanying the prospect to a campus athletics event
- may **NOT** utilize the prospective student-athlete host monies to purchase souvenirs such as T-shirts, hats or other institutional mementos
- may **NOT** give the prospective student-athlete, his parents/legal guardian or spouse cash during their official visit
- may **NOT** use a vehicle provided or arranged by any institutional staff member or representative of athletics interest
- may **NOT** allow recruiting conversations to occur, on or off campus between the prospect and a representative of athletics interest, if a unavoidable contact occurs, only an exchange of greetings is permitted
- may **NOT** conduct a tryout in the presence of a coach, institutional staff member or representative of athletics interest
