**WHAT:** Earth Sciences Field Excursion, ESCI 4701/6701, 2 credit hours

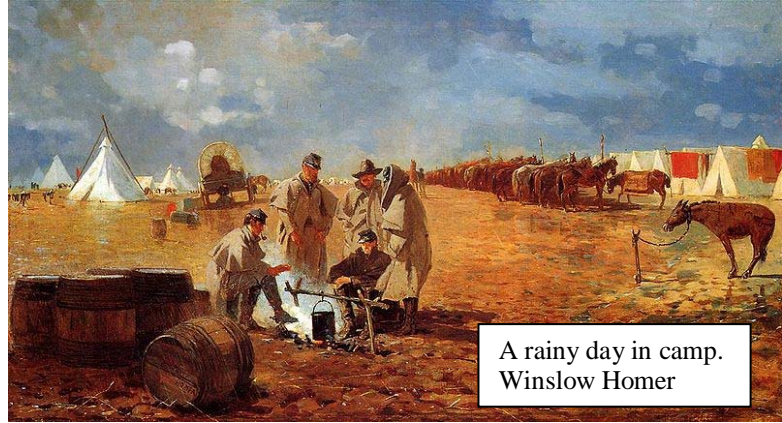
**WHEN:** Spring break, Saturday March 5 to Friday March 11, 2011.

**REGISTRATION:** MUST ENROLL DURING REGULAR SPRING 2011 REGISTRATION.

**COSTS:** A charge of \$150 per student (tentative estimate subject to change, assumes 12 students) covers campsite rental, boat rental, camp food, van costs, and motels if needed. It does not include tuition or university fees, meals while in transit, and personal expenses. Any overcharge will be returned after the trip.

**PREREQUISITE/REQUIREMENTS:** Students must have completed any one of the following courses; Physical Geology, Historical Geology, Environmental Geology, Landforms, Fundamentals of Archaeology. Students (and faculty) must be able to hike over broken ground for distances that can exceed a mile.

**GRADE:** A post-trip term paper will integrate field notebook notes and photos.

**TENTATIVE PLANS.** Pre trip meetings in early 2011 at times to be arranged. We will discuss travel and camp arrangements and detailed program plans. Post trip meetings will discuss of term paper details and exchange photos. A trip log listing potential stops and campsite locations is in preparation.
