**DESCRIPTION:** This fellowship is awarded to deserving and qualified graduate students in the Herff College of Engineering, with those pursuing doctoral degrees given preference. Recipients may receive the award, in the amount of \$5,000/year, for a maximum of three years.

**DEADLINE:** Applications must be postmarked by March 27, 2009. Decisions will be determined by April 17, 2009.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be admitted as full-time MS or PhD graduate students in the Herff College of Engineering. Under-represented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

**CRITERIA FOR AWARDING FELLOWSHIPS:** The candidate must:

- Meet all requirements for admission into the Herff College of Engineering
- Have and maintain a GPA of no less than 3.25
- Possess excellent verbal and written communication skills
