Self-Managed Advising Sheet

- You are responsible for scheduling courses in your program. Before enrolling in any course, you must satisfy any prerequisites that are listed in the current Graduate Bulletin. Consult with the Graduate Advisor about your program or other professional concerns.
- **Teacher Education Program** – All students must apply to TEP by the deadline of their first semester and fulfill all TEP requirements before the end of that semester. You must have a 2.75 undergraduate GPA to take courses. Students should take the Content Knowledge Exam and PPST for Admission.
- **Master of Arts in Teaching** - If you are planning to receive the degree and did not start as degree seeking, you must become degree seeking before you have completed more than 12 hours.
- **Licensure Exams**- You will have multiple Praxis II exams to take to be fully licensed, check with your advisor to make sure you are aware of all required exams.
