Health Information

The University Health Center

IEI students have access to The University Health Center (Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. - 4 p.m.) for general health services. In your application packet, you completed a medical history form for the Health Center. This gives the Health Center permission to treat you if you are sick or injured.

TB test

All new F-1 students are required to be tested for Tuberculosis (TB) at The University Health Center. New IEI students will be tested during their orientation. The cost of the skin test is \$20.00. Students showing positive results are also required to have a chest X-ray (\$20.00) in order to attend class.

MMR

All new students must provide proof that they have received a measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR) vaccination since 1980. Please bring a copy of the health report (in English) indicating that you have had the measles vaccine. If you have not been fully vaccinated against measles or do not bring proof of vaccination, you must get the MMR vaccine here in Memphis.

Hepatitis B and meningitis

The University of Memphis is required to provide information about hepatitis B to all new students and information about meningitis to all students living in university housing. You will receive an information sheet when you register. Vaccinations for both diseases are available at The University Health Center.
