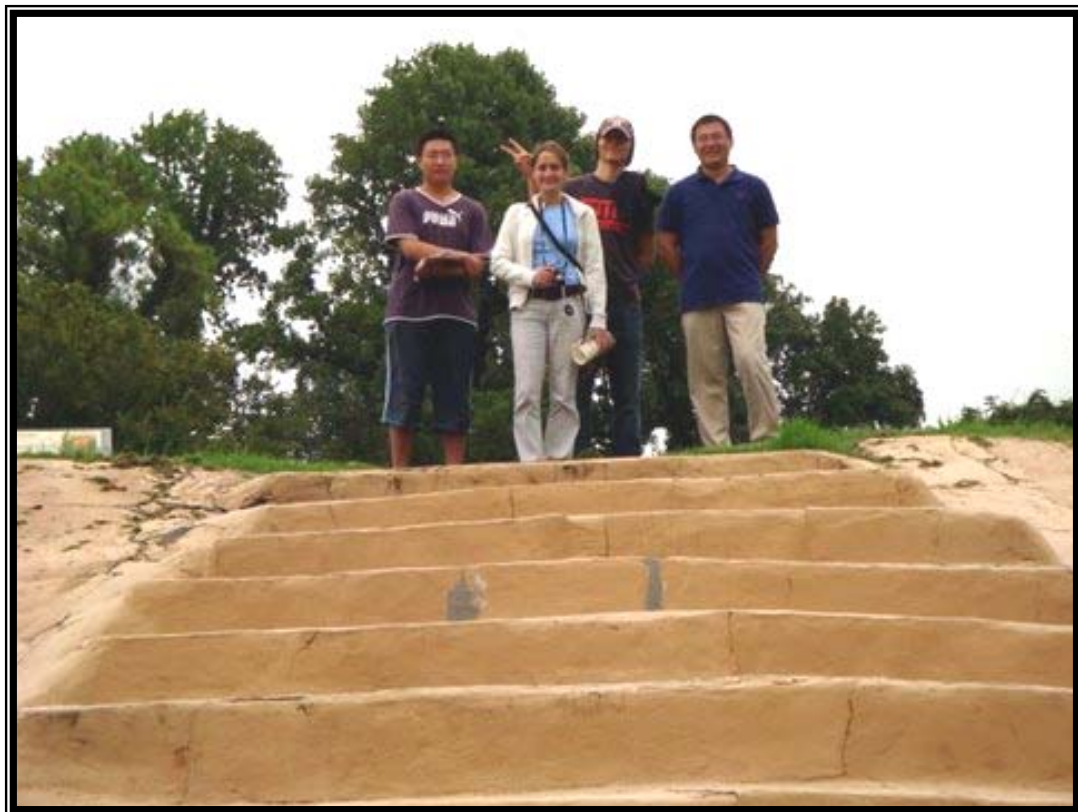
My Summer at Disneyland in Los Angeles
