We are pleased to provide information to you regarding our Dual Degree plan. The Dual Degree plan is a collaborative arrangement between The University of Memphis and Jackson State Community College. This program allows students to complete requirements for the Associate of Science Nursing degree (ASN) while pursuing their Bachelor of Science Nursing degree (BSN).

Some of the advantages to this arrangement are:

- General education courses may be completed at Jackson State Community College
- U of M nursing courses are offered on-line
- There is a seamless transfer between the courses of study
- No transition courses are required
- Tuition prices at state rates
- After completing the ASN, the BSN may be finished in 3 semesters of part time on-line course work.
