GREENE POWER: A New Twist on a Turbine The University Libraries, the University of Memphis with the support of the Friends of Libraries invite you to a presentation by inventor Geoff Greene and Dr. John Hochstein, U of M professor of mechanical engineering about a turbine idea **at noon on Wednesday, Sept. 15**, in the McWherter Library rotunda. The event is free and open to the public.

The invention captures hydrokinetic energy to produce electricity. The turbine size needed for the invention to work led Greene to come to the U of M's Center for Biofuel Energy and Sustainable Technologies for help in submitting a proposal to the U.S. Department of Energy for funding to produce the turbine. (Patent pending)

The related exhibit will be on display in the library rotunda from September 13 – 24, 2010 and includes an illustration and a wooden model. Parking is available in the Innovation Drive or Zach Curlin parking garages or in the Central Avenue parking lot.
