

LSON students in the Community Health Nursing Program provided the men and women of the Memphis Union Mission Drop-In Center basic foot care and education in The Foot Clinic held in October and November of 2010. A total of 46 men were seen as a result of these two clinics.

Our students will return to the Memphis Union Mission twice this spring and again in early summer, once again offering foot soaks, foot massages with lotion, nail clippings, sore bandaging, and treatment of conditions by over-the-counter methods. As more and more individuals become aware of the Foot Clinic, we anticipate increased participation. While the list of supplies used in the Foot Clinic this fall is provided below, there are on-going needs for socks, shoes, and over-the-counter medications.
