NSSE 2004:	more than 400 colleges and universities are expected to participate in the spring 2004 administration.
NSSE 2003:	more than 420 colleges and universities are participating in the spring 2003 administration.
NSSE 2002:	367 colleges and universities participated in the spring 2002 administration.
NSSE 2001:	321 colleges and universities participated in the spring 2001 administration.
NSSE 2000:	276 colleges and universities participated in the spring 2000 administration.
1999 Pilots:	Approximately 70 colleges and universities participated in the spring and fall, 1999 pilots
