NEIGHBORHOOD

Binghampton, historic neighborhood located in the geographic center of Memphis

CHALLENGE

The Hispanic residents in Binghampton represent a sizeable and growing portion of the neighborhood, with some families residing in the area for over a decade. This group remains underrepresented in community activities and without a voice in planning for the future. Language and cultural differences create barriers for participation.

IDEA

Create a culturally sensitive approach to:

- Establish outreach programs for Hispanic residents to include these neighbors in community-wide events
- Aid Hispanic residents' access to social, health and educational services
- Begin regular communication with residents in Spanish
