

THE 100 CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To be eligible for The 100 Club Scholarship applicants must be a former or present Memphis or Shelby County Law Enforcement or Fire Department personnel or an immediate family member. Immediate family members of deceased law enforcement or fire department personnel are also eligible to apply. No individual can receive this scholarship for more than two semesters. Applicant must be a high school graduate with at least a 2.5 cumulative high school GPA and NO previous college credits. Applicants must maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA to be eligible to receive the award for the 2nd semester. Please note additional specific requirements on reverse side. You will be notified by official letter if you have been awarded the 100 Club Scholarship. You will be notified by email/portal announcement if you were not selected for the scholarship.

- (a) _____ currently employed or retired law enforcement officer or fire-fighter with Shelby County or the City of Memphis
- (b) _____ the spouse of someone who meets the criteria listed in (a)
- (c) _____ the child (natural or adopted) of someone who meets the criteria in (a). Children over the age of 18, must live in the same household as someone who meets the criteria listed in (a)
- (d) _____ the stepchild, under the age of 18, must live in the same household as someone who meets the criteria listed in (a)

Please indicate above, with an "X", all of the criteria that you meet and provide the information below. Current law enforcement officers or fire-fighters must have a five year service record. Retired personnel must have a ten year service record. In either case, the police officer or fire-fighter must have at least five years of service as a "first responder" or the equivalent. The service periods must be years of full-time, commissioned service. Eligibility is invalid if the officer's or fire-fighter's employment ended due to misconduct.

This completed form must be stamped with the certified Records official stamp of the City of Memphis or Shelby County (whichever is appropriate). This form must be submitted to the Scholarship Office no later than March 1st 2012.
