

Community College Transfer and Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship Application 2010-2011

This application places the applicant's name in consideration for the Community College Transfer or Phi Theta Kappa Scholarships. You will not be considered for any transfer programs if concurrently enrolled at The University of Memphis and a community college or if you are a current University of Memphis student of more than one semester. All scholarships are awarded in the fall for the academic year. Mid-year graduates (Fall graduates) may apply for consideration if funds are available for the Spring semester and may also be considered for the following Fall semester. Please read the conditions outlined below for each scholarship program.

1. Please complete in ink or type. Complete each item. Use N/A for items that do not apply to you.
2. Apply for admission and be accepted by **March 1, 2010**, to the University as a regular degree seeking undergraduate.
3. This application must be received by **March 1, 2010**, by the Scholarship Office.
4. You must be a citizen or permanent resident of the United States.

_____ **Community College Transfer:** Scholarship award is \$6,500 per year. All applicants must have obtained an Associate's Degree from a Tennessee Community College with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5. The Community College Transfer Scholarship is awarded on a competitive basis and award recipients must attend school full time. Community College Transfer Scholarship recipients cannot receive any other academic scholarships. Students who have been named to the Phi Theta Kappa All-Tennessee Academic Team receive this scholarship automatically upon completion of their Associate's Degree. If you are named to the Phi Theta Kappa All-Tennessee Academic Team, please notify the Scholarship Office at (901) 678-3213. For a one-year renewal, recipients must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and complete 150 service hours per year. Students who graduate from a community college located in one of the Memphis Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA) (5 counties), who are also either a Tennessee resident or a resident of an MSA county (all MSA counties listed on back of this page), may also apply and be considered for this scholarship.

_____ **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship:** Awarded to incoming Phi Theta Kappa members with an Associate's Degree from a community college who are not receiving any other academic scholarship. Recipients of this scholarship must attend school full time. Tennessee residency is **not** required for this scholarship. You must submit a copy of your PTK Certificate or Membership Card with your application to be considered for this scholarship. The award is valued at \$1000 per academic year. For a one-year renewal, recipients must maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA and complete 75 hours per year service requirement.
