- ❖ **The 2009-2010 winner of the "See Me Award", the Student Disability Services Outstanding Faculty Award, is Dr. Sarah Clark Miller.**

Here is some information about the award:

The **Student Disability Services Outstanding Faculty Award**, honors a University of Memphis faculty member who has been nominated by a student with a disability who is registered with Student Disability Services. Because many people are uncomfortable openly discussing issues of disability, the award is titled the "**See Me Award**" and the student nominee must write an essay detailing ways that the faculty member has shown understanding of disability and willingness to learn about disability. The student nominator must also give examples of how the faculty member has demonstrated their willingness to assist the student as a learner. Most importantly, the faculty member must show respect in seeing the student and his or her ABILITIES, while acknowledging issues of disability.

The award will be presented at the President's Leadership Recognition Awards on Sunday, April 25, 2010 at 2:00 PM in the University Center Ballroom.
