- American Universities abroad offer US-style, English-based classes
 - More academic freedom, more relaxed in the US than abroad

- Study Abroad checks with State Department to determine areas of risk. If State Department says it is too risky to travel there, the University of Memphis does not send students there.
 - Government problems
