## CAREER TRACKS

### Taxation: 12 hours

**Selecting** ACCT 7510, ACCT 7511, 1 Data Analytics elective, and 1 Accounting or Data Analytics elective constitutes a tax concentration.

### CPA: 12 hours

**Selecting** ACCT 7242, 2 Data Analytics electives, and 1 Accounting or Data Analytics elective constitutes a CPA concentration.

### Data Analytics: 12 hours

**Selecting** 4 Data Analytics electives constitutes a data analytics concentration.

**Notes:** ACCT 7050 and 7080 are not acceptable courses for this degree. An internship does not count as credit toward the degree, but is reported on the transcript. There is a limitation of three 6000-level courses for credit toward the MS degree.

<sup>1</sup> Not required if you took Intermediate Accounting as a two-course sequence.

<sup>2</sup> If you have taken the undergraduate equivalent of this course, you have satisfied this core requirement, and you may not take this course again as a graduate student. You must take an additional accounting elective to satisfy the 21 accounting hours required for the degree.

<sup>3</sup> ACCT 7626 (FAR and REG) is offered in the Spring semester. ACCT 7627 (AUD and BEC) is offered in the Fall semester. Whichever course you take first will count as 3 hours toward your MS degree. The course you take second will count as 3 hours toward the 150 hours needed for the CPA license. There is an additional fee for Becker materials that cover all four exam sections.
