Roll with the Punches: a networking and support group for individuals who use wheelchairs. This group normally meets on the fourth (4th) Friday of every month.

BRAINIACTS: A support and informational group for individuals with traumatic brain injuries, strokes and other acquired brain disorders. This group normally meets on the third (3rd) Friday of every month.
