**What exactly is the GRE® test?** The General Records Examination (GRE®) is accepted among graduate schools as part of the admission process. There are three sections of the test which focus on verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, and analytical writing.

GRE® preparation classes are offered through learning centers and other educational sites. There is a major need for a preparation class geared specifically to individuals with visual and/or physical disabilities.
