- 4. Social Statistics: One of PSYC 3010, SOCI 3311.
- # Students may not take both MATH 1710 and 1730 or both 1720 and 1730 to fulfill the Gen. Ed. Math and B.A. Math/Natural Science requirements.

RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS:

A student will satisfy residence requirements for graduation by earning at least twenty-five (25) percent of credit hours required for the degree at the University of Memphis. At least thirty (30) of the final sixty (60) hours required for the degree must be completed at the University of Memphis. A student transferring credits from a two-year college or institution must complete, as a requirement for the baccalaureate degree, a minimum of sixty semester hours in an accredited senior institution. A transfer student in The College of Arts and Sciences must earn at least 6 semester hours in residence in the major subject and at least 3 semester hours in the minor. These credits may be earned only through regular class enrollment for a letter grade.

ACADEMIC CHECK-OUT FOR GRADUATION:

All students in the College of Arts and Sciences must complete their Application to Graduate at the beginning of the semester at least one year before they plan to graduate in myMemphis in the Graduation and Commencement Channel on the My Degree tab. After the application is filed, the graduation analyst will complete the Summary of Coursework Remaining form and will e-mail copies to the student and to the advisor. Students should print a copy of the Summary of Coursework Remaining and discuss it with their advisor. If you have any questions about the graduation process, call (901) 678-5454. If you and your advisor have questions about coursework remaining, the **advisor** should contact the graduation analyst (majones@memphis.edu or snisar@memphis.edu).

Once you have submitted the Application to Graduate, if you decide to change your expected graduation date, you must notify us at casgraduation@memphis.edu. Otherwise, if all requirements are met, the student's graduation will be certified for the semester on the application.
