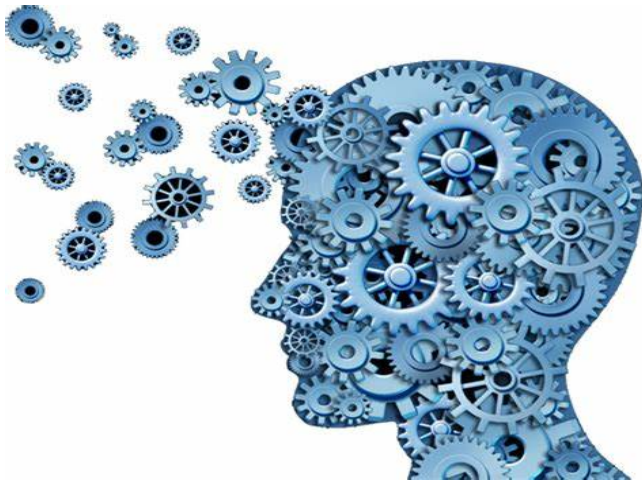
Attend Class

Class is where you get the information that will be on homework, exams, etc.

Engage in class discussions & Ask Questions





Review Syllabi

Reviewing your Syllabi prior to the start of courses:

- Give you a snapshot of what to expect in your course (*i.e. required assignments, timeline – dates & due dates*)
- Helps you analyze whether you have overloaded yourself with too many **HEAVY** courses
- Assists with organizing your semester



Be Prepared

Make an honest effort to have ALL books, access codes, & materials for class before class starts.



Game Plan

It's always a good idea to:

Stay organized

- Purchase a planner (*even if you're a DUDE!*)

Work ahead on assignments

- Allow space and time for more enjoyable extracurricular activities and emergencies

- Try to make your “pleasures” align with your goals



Game Plan

Prioritize

Continuously Enroll

- Maintain your GPA
 - Avoid C-, D, F
 - What about “W” & “I”
- Know the Academic Standing Policy
 - 2.00 Term and Overall Combined GPA is needed to maintain Good Standing
- Know the Repeat Policy
 - The first repeat replaces the original grade (regardless if you do better or worse)
 - 2nd attempts and beyond are averaged together
