Log in to myMemphis.

Enter your USER NAME (same as email address).

Enter your PASSWORD (same as email password).

Click on the STUDENT tab.

Under REGISTRATION TOOLS in the middle of the page, click on ADD or DROP CLASSES.

Select Spring 2012. Click Submit.

Enter the Course Reference Number (CRN) for each of the classes you are registering for (far left column on your registration worksheet).

Click Submit Changes.

See your counselor if you receive any error messages or are unable to register.
