




## **2023 Funding by Source**

## **Research Development**

- The Office of Research Development assists faculty with their first proposals, organizes large proposals, organizes training, and helps with strategic growth of the UofM capacity.
- **Step 1:** Contact Research Development
- **Step 2:** Access Professional Development
  - A calendar of all the training sessions for academic year 2023-2024. One-on-one sessions are also available on any topic as needed. Recorded training content and slides are available at <a href="this-link">this link</a>.
  - Compliance is critical, so be sure to review the slides on **Research Compliance** and *complete all required trainings* for human subject research, financial conflicts of interest, export controls, and animal care and use.

# Submitting your proposal/Award Management



The **Office of Research Enterprise Services** is responsible for submitting your proposals to sponsor and the financial management of your award through closeout.

- **Step 4:** Meet Your RES Team
  - **Dr. Terrice Watson** (<u>twnfield@memphis.edu</u>), Assistant Vice President for Research Administration and Compliance.
  - **Stephanie Thompson or Laura Wright** (<u>osp@memphis.edu</u>) will be the pre-award specialist for grants. Your unit may also have a pre-award coordinator (contact your chair for more information).
  - **Lauren Williams** (<u>ospawards@memphis.edu</u>) sets up your awards in the system and transfers them to Post Award Services.
  - Cheryl Hayes and Mattie Haynes (<u>opam@memphis.edu</u>) are our Post Award Research Support Analysts.
  - **Linda Heide** (<u>grants@memphis.edu</u>) is the Director of Post Award Services.
- **Step 5:** Create your <u>Cayuse</u> Record
  - Cayuse is our internal database for tracking sponsored activities and is also used to directly submit most federal grants.
  - Every proposal or research engagement that you submit needs a Cayuse SP record. Make sure you create this as early as possible to notify the OSP team of your intention to submit.
