Executive Summary



The College of Arts and Sciences has invested strongly in the institution achieving Carnegie R1 status while maintaining strong academic programs that prepare students for a wide variety of career pathways. We are piloting partnerships and collecting data on how such partnerships influence student success, are continuing successful faculty scholarship support programs, and are developing new online courses and programs to increase flexibility to allow students to reach their educational goals.

- Launch CAS Research Council (planning initiated and then paused due to reluctance to add service responsibilities during the pandemic)
 - Advisory to Dean on emerging interdisciplinary research areas that may constitute strategic investment opportunities (of faculty positions, research stimulus funding, research development time investment, and new academic program opportunities)
- Invest in Data Science to support continued dramatic academic program growth and strong external funding success

Challenges



- R1 Maintenance Challenges
 - Post-award support is intensifying as a pain point that impedes scholarly progress and research expenditures
 - Uncompetitive salary structure (for both staff and faculty) has led to loss of institutional knowledge and valued skills
 - Lack of health insurance for GAs puts CAS units at a competitive disadvantage in graduate student recruitment
 - Aiming to invest in areas traditionally under -resourced while maintaining strengths in other areas
- Pandemic Challenges
 - Increased number of tenure clock stop requests
 - Publisher timelines lengthening after submission
 - Mental health challenges increasing for students, faculty, and staff

Major Initiatives



- Working with Office of the Provost to pilot on -demand peer tutoring (platform managed by Knack): retention/graduation
- Development Priority is funding for Experiential Learning Fellowships: retention/graduation
- PDA/FRG/Freeburg Fellows/Research Equipment Cost Sharing (ongoing): faculty research/scholarly productivity
- Continuing investments in instructional faculty in departments with high PT faculty usage: retention/graduation
- Continuing development of career pathways for students through baccalaureate programs and into professional graduate programs (medicine, medical laboratory sciences, pharmacy, law, and others) and teaching careers: recruitment/student success
- CERI: Director transition: R1 maintenance
- Social Media Campaign: ABC's of CAS and CAS Scavenger Hunt designed to increase frequency and impact of CAS social media postings

Proposed Upcoming Strategic Investments



- Data Science: MS program in Data Science has grown over three terms from 5, to 35, to 70 tuition -paying students with additional growth anticipated
 - Full-time administrative support needed
 - Faculty needed to enable design of data science courses that can accommodate students entering from multiple backgrounds (1 requested here, additional growth will likely require additional lines in the future)
- Institute of Intelligent Systems: links and supports research interests of faculty from psychology, communication sciences and disorders, mathematical sciences, English, philosophy, World Languages, public health, and other units
 - Support placed in IIS effectively supports multiple areas, with new faculty lines and research software developers critical to current and future externally funded projects
