Recent police shootings and subsequent protests have focused new public attention on the issue of accountability in law enforcement.

These events have also triggered public dialogue regarding the probability of body cameras as the solution to related issues. Recent surveys suggest that approximately 25% of the nation's 17,000 police agencies are using body worn cameras and of those agencies, 80% are evaluating the technology.
