### EARLY CARE & LEARNING PROFESSIONALS

### LENA/NURTURING PARENTING

Enhance parents' knowledge of child development particularly in language and social emotional development through LENA Start and Nurturing Parenting, a 13-week language enhancement program conducted once a week at your site for your parent group. Weekly incentives and childcare can be provided.

### ASQ DEVELOPMENTAL SCREENINGS

On-site training in the administration of the ASQ-3 and ASQ S/E to assess how children are doing in important areas such as speech, physical ability, social skills, and problem-solving skills. Can help identify child's strengths as well as areas in which child may need support. Teachers will also learn how to implement classroom activities that support social/emotional development.
