The Coordinated Effort to Enhance Development

The University of Memphis is offering this Early Care & Learning Professionals (ECLP) development opportunity to support a workforce that works directly with children in early childhood care settings. The goal of this training series is to bring awareness to adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), child development, brain development and social and emotional development to enhance current knowledge and skills.

This **8-week course** will consist of **five classroom sessions** and **two classroom observation sessions**. Participants are eligible to receive up to 25 training hours, incentives of up to \$500 per program, in center materials and equipment upon completion.

All trainings provided by the University of Memphis are accepted by the Department of Human Services. Certificates will be provided.
