## PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The ImagineU Summer Entrepreneurship Accelerator program is a unique, immersive and intensive 8-week entrepreneurial experience in which students learn and live the early stages of their entrepreneurship journey. During the program, students will identify problems at the intersections of their passion, experience and knowledge, and will start a company with other students around the most compelling and feasible opportunities identified in the early stages of the program.

- **Program End Date:** Friday, July 24, 2026

**Applications are due by April 5, 2026, at 11:59PM.** The program is competitive; we don't recommend waiting until the last minute to apply. We're not looking for people that want a backup plan. We are looking for motivated students that are serious about experiencing real-world entrepreneurship and understand they are going to start a viable business venture during this program.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Program Dates: June 1 – July 24, 2026

Commitment: 25 hours per week (Core activities 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM, Monday–Friday)

2 absences will result in departure from the ImagineU program.

## ELIGIBILITY

### STUDENT STATUS

The ImagineU Summer Accelerator is an interdisciplinary program. To be eligible for this program, you must be a University of Memphis student within a qualifying major and be pursuing one of the following three academic paths for Summer 2026. Students must be graduating in December 2026 or later. Transfer students are accepted based on acceptance to the University of Memphis. Incoming graduate students accepted based on their acceptance into a University of Memphis graduate program.

- Internship Track:** I am seeking or have secured internship credits through my department for this 8-week immersion.

- 14) What do you most hope to gain from this summer experience? What impact will it have on you? (150-400 words)
