Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The ServiceNow Flow Designer will support the Raymond James Request Management team in modernizing the ServiceNow environment by converting legacy Workflow Catalog Items into the Flow Designer framework. They will provide support in ensuring a smooth and accurate migration of existing ServiceNow workflows and contribute to the ongoing process of improvement efforts. This role will involve collaborating with developers, process owners, and company stakeholders.

This position requires excellent attention to detail, strong problem-solving abilities, and above average communications skills.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review existing catalog items and assist in mapping legacy workflow functionality to Flow Designer equivalents
- Collaborate with developers, process owners, and Raymond James stakeholders to clarify requirements and validate migrated flows.
- Thoroughly and accurately document configuration steps, decisions, and migration details to support future maintenance and knowledge transfer.
- Troubleshoot issues during testing phases and escalate problems as needed
- Contribute ideas and participate in discussions for improving processes and ensuring smooth migration.
- Ensure adherence to internal and external communication protocols, meeting weekly with UMRF Ventures management.
- Review and interpret scripting logic (JavaScript/Glide) at a conceptual level to support migration analysis, recognizing script patterns, dependencies, and functional behaviors that inform migration decisions
- Comply with all UMRF Ventures and Raymond James guidelines and policies.
