Externship Overview

This position is ideal for motivated **4th-year audiology students** seeking a comprehensive **clinical externship**.

- Direct **mentorship and supervision** in cochlear implants, vestibular assessments, and auditory processing disorders
- Increased **clinical independence** in hearing evaluations and hearing aid appointments
- Exposure to a broad patient population across the lifespan and varied clinical experiences
- **Start Date:** Flexible June 2027-August 2027
- **Externship Timeline:** June 2027-May 2028
- **Compensation:** Paid hourly, up to 37.5 hours per week. Not eligible for benefits or overtime.

Responsibilities

Externs will **actively participate** in a variety of clinical services, including:

- Electrophysiological testing
- Auditory processing disorder evaluations and therapy
- Cochlear implant evaluations and programming
- Adult and pediatric hearing evaluations
- Adult and pediatric hearing aid fittings and management
- Hearing aid specification verification
- Access-to-care programs

Assignments will consider the student's learning goals and the clinic's service needs.
