



Key Acalog Terms:

Gateway-what external users see in the system.

Publisher-internal user access for making changes available on a public domain.

Hierarchy-data structure used for organization of the institution. For example, University of Memphis>College of Arts & Sciences>Department of English.

Courses-lifeblood of the catalog. Maintained by Manager level access.

Cores-are headings for a major that has information or courses attached to them.

Permalink- are dynamic links that update everywhere in the catalog once a change is made.

Modules- are tabs or clickable text within the Publisher.

Ad-hoc-feature used to explain courses further.
