




Mission: To prepare professionals through our teaching, research, and service to address societal opportunities and challenges, fostering positive change and a more socially just society.


Cohort Members per Year


What is this metric?

This metric shows the racial and ethnic composition of the three-year cohort.


Praxis Leader Licensure Pass Rate
