Interpretation of the Data:

Completer data for advanced programs indicate an increase in the number of candidates completing advanced degrees during the reporting period. The Educator Preparation Provider (EPP) awarded 8 advanced degrees in 2023–2024 and 19 advanced degrees in 2024–2025, reflecting growth in several leadership-focused programs.

Within the Instruction and Curriculum Leadership programs, the number of completers increased from 3 to 7, with candidates completing concentrations in Literacy and School Library Information Specialist, the latter showing the largest growth during the reporting period. Leadership-focused programs within Leadership and Policy Studies also demonstrated growth, increasing from 5 completers in 2023–2024 to 12 completers in 2024–2025. This growth was largely driven by increased enrollment in the Student

Affairs Administration concentration, while School Administration and Supervision maintained consistent completer numbers across both academic years.

Overall, the data indicate increasing participation in advanced programs that prepare educators and professionals for leadership roles in schools and higher education settings. These data are reviewed annually by EPP leadership and program faculty to monitor enrollment trends, support program planning, and inform continuous improvement efforts.
