In 2024–25, the College of Education saw overall enrollment growth, rising from 1,232 to 1,403 students, while graduation numbers remained stable at 361. The Counseling program led to this growth, with enrollment increasing from 194 to 242 and the number of graduates rising from 58 to 70. The small Education program doubled its graduates from 2 to 4 alongside a modest rise in enrollment. ICL enrollment grew from 864 to 978, though graduations dropped slightly from 269 to 254, and the Leadership program saw modest enrollment growth from 179 to 190 with a small decline in graduates from 37 to 33. Overall, the College is experiencing strong enrollment growth, steady graduation rates, and opportunities to support timely program completion in certain areas.
