Outstanding Research and Scholarship Award Criteria

DESCRIPTION

The UofM COE Outstanding Research and Scholarship Activity Award recognizes and encourages faculty excellence in academic research and scholarship. Nominations will be based on sustaining an above-average level of research, scholarship, or grant productivity throughout the previous calendar year. One COE Outstanding Research and Scholarship Award will be awarded annually.

ELIGIBILITY

Full-time UoM COE tenure-track and research faculty. An individual can only receive the award once in a three-year cycle.

NOMINATION PROCEDURE

Department Chairs or faculty can nominate for this award. Self-nominations will NOT be accepted.

1. The nominator should ensure nominee's eligibility.
2. Include a 1-page (maximum) summary highlighting nominee's research and scholarship activities addressing the significance of the nominee's research, scholarship, or grant activity.
3. Provide at least one, but no more than two letters of faculty support for the nominee. Letters of support should emphasize the above-average level of research, scholarship, and grant productivity within two pages.
4. Include the nominee's abbreviated vita or resume emphasizing the nominee's research, scholarship, and or grant activity.
