 - This measures the teachers' ability to meet the objectives and needs of the students.


Trend Analysis

Data from 2019-2020 indicates that the University of Memphis completers' TVAAS Data at Level 3 or above and at Level 4 or above exceeds the State of Tennessee averages. The 2019-2020 data also indicates that our completers' Level of Effectiveness for completers scoring at Level 3 or above and at Level 4 or above is slightly lower than the state averages. This follows a three-year trend.


We can attribute this trend to strong preparation that focuses on assessment of students and planning subsequent lessons based on analyzed data.

Percentage of Cohort Members whose Student Growth (TVAAS) Scores are Level 4 or Above


