**Trend Analysis**

Our numbers remain consistent with the fluctuations in enrollment.

The vast majority of our candidates are licensed at the initial level. Initial level licensure at the University of Memphis refers to an Initial Practitioner License offered at the BSED level. Initial licensure candidates might also receive a Job Embedded Practitioner (JEP) Teaching License while working as a teacher in a classroom and completing a Master of Arts in Teaching Program of Studies in one of many areas.

At this time, we do not differentiate in the data base between those securing initial licensure from a Bachelor's of Science or Master of Arts Program.

An Advanced License is a Professional License beyond the Practitioner License. Several of our certificate program can lead to advanced teacher licensure separate from a degree program. The candidate in these programs must already hold a Practitioner License.

**Data**

The total number of Initial and Advanced candidates who passed TN licensure exams in their respective fields. Some candidates can be recommended for multiple licenses due to the nature of their dual program, or upon passing the appropriate PRAXIS exam.
