Dean & Department Chairs

Responsible for overseeing faculty and ensuring implementation of curricular, assessment, and quality assurance practices.

College of Education Dean

Provides Oversight & management of the Educator Preparation Provider (EPP).

Director of Assessment, Accreditation & Accountability

Responsibilities:

- * Using CAEP Evaluation Frameworks for EPP-created Assessments & Surveys

- * Share & discuss data with departmental faculty.
- * Revision of key assessments.

Director of Teacher Education &Clinical Practice Responsibilities:

- * Monitors Field and Clinical Placements
