Avoid Overturning Your PIT

Safe Travel Rules

Always follow all Safe Travel Rules when operating a PIT.

Surface Conditions

- 1. Be aware of the travel conditions along your planned route.
- 2. Slow down for wet and slippery floors.
- 3. Watch for surface obstructions even a small bump can cause a load to fall off elevated forks.
- **4.** Cross railroad tracks at a 45-degree angle wherever possible.
- **5.** Avoid running over loose objects.
- **6.** Be especially careful on loading docks stay away from the edge.
- **7.** Ensure that dockboards or bridgeplates are secure before driving over them; proceed carefully and slowly and never exceed stated capacity.

Turning

- 1. Slow down when turning and use extra caution, especially when working in confined areas or narrow aisles.
- 2. Turn the steering wheel in a smooth, sweeping motion.
- **3.** Anticipate the rear-end swing and start the turn as close to the inside corner as possible. When the lift truck turns a corner, the rear of the lift truck swings in the opposite direction of the turn.
- **4.** Use caution when turning with forks elevated.

Grades

- 1. Travel on grades slowly.
- 2. Always drive loaded trucks with the load upgrade.
- 3. Always drive unloaded trucks with the forks downgrade.
- 4. Never turn on a grade.
