Powered Industrial Truck Safety

Safe Travel Rules for Powered Industrial Trucks



- 1. Be aware of your surroundings in all directions. Look in all directions before beginning to operate your PIT.
- 2. Plan your route.
- 3. Keep a clear view.
- 4. Always look in the direction of travel if the load blocks your view, travel in reverse.
- **5.** Do not travel with a load elevated higher than needed to clear the ground surface.
- 6. Observe all traffic regulations, including authorized plant speed limits.
- 7. Maintain a safe distance, approximately three truck lengths from the truck ahead.
- **8.** Keep the truck under control at all times.
- 9. Yield the right of way to ambulances, fire trucks, and other vehicles in emergency situations.
- 10. Do not pass other trucks traveling in the same direction at intersections, blind spots, or other dangerous locations.
- 11. Operate at a speed that will permit the truck to be stopped in a safe manner under all travel conditions.
- 12. Do not engage in stunt driving and rowdy behavior or pranks.
- 13. Come to a complete stop before changing directions.
