Catalog Description

Major texts of literary heritage; modes of literary expression and cultural context; emphasis on works as products of their historical contexts and as processes shaping human consciousness; composition and critical thinking beyond levels expected of freshmen.

PREREQUISITE: ENGL 1010 and 1020, with a minimum grade of "C," or their equivalent. [G]

Course Summary

Goals include exposing students to various examples of fiction, poetry, and drama by diverse contemporary and canonical authors from a range of time periods. Because the idea of change is fundamental in so many works of literature, the theme of transformation will provide a lens through which to examine selected stories, poems, and plays.

Course requirements will include reader responses, analytical papers, and an original short story.
