ENGL 3603: Engineering Communication Dr. Liz Lane Summer 2020

This course explores the form and contexts of written and oral communications in engineering professions, with each core assignment offering extensive practice in oral reporting, written reports, manuals, and proposals. ENGL 3603 emphasizes the fundamentals of technical communication, focusing on the needs of practicing engineers and contexts specific to the engineering domain. Because writing in the workplace often entails collaboration, your view of writing will likely shift to include the interactions through which you accomplish project and writing goals *with* other people and through a variety of tools, such as document design software, digital collaborative writing tools, and various technical writing genres.
