This is an upper-level undergraduate fiction workshop focusing on students' own original writing and the analysis of published short stories and novels. Building on skills developed in ENGL 3607 or ENGL 3608, students will further develop their use of literary technique, focusing on language, character, dialogue, setting, plot, point of view, structure and more. Throughout the semester, we will examine different genres of fiction writing, such as literary fiction, horror, science fiction and fantasy, speculative fiction, mystery and suspense, Westerns, romance and more by reading and discussing a wide variety of stories. This workshop is a supportive environment where students can share their work and grow as writers. May be repeated for maximum of 6 hours credit with permission of instructor.
