General Requirements:

1. A minimum of 33 hours of graduate credit beyond the bachelor's degree is required. Students in Literature must complete 30 hours of course work plus a 3-hour thesis, or 33 hours of course work.¹
2. Students must also complete a written comprehensive exam.

Literature Requirements:

At least 18 hours of Literature courses including ENGL 7000, which should be taken in the first year of graduate study. Students must take at least one literature course from before 1800 and one literature course from after 1800, as well as at least one Literary Theory class, which may be chosen from any designated theory class, including ENGL 7336, 7701, 7702, and / or 7480.
