

# BA in English Outcomes

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Students enrolled in the BA in English program will:

<b>1.</b>	Identify connections among language, thinking, and writing and interpret the persuasive and aesthetic effects of language use in context, including in their own work.
<b>2.</b>	Compose innovative, compelling, and creative texts that effectively respond to and construct rhetorical situations, academic or otherwise.
<b>3.</b>	Demonstrate a working knowledge of foundational works in English studies and deeper competencies for works within a chosen concentration.
<b>4.</b>	Engage with and apply a variety of theories and methodologies (linguistic, literary, critical, rhetorical, creative, cultural) to diverse texts and contexts.
<b>5.</b>	Evaluate how language constructs identity, subject positions, and affiliations, including but not limited to race, ethnicity, gender, class, and sexuality.
<b>6.</b>	Locate, analyze, use, and document source material ethically, effectively, and professionally, employing traditional and emerging technologies.
