GUIDELINES

- The quiz is <u>not</u> limited to Latin students; students who are currently enrolled in any language class may participate.
- Maximum of three entries per class.

FORMAT

- Students will assemble in a room furnished with tables or desks and will be provided a pencil
 and a copy of the quiz.
- The quiz will consist of 20-25 multiple choice questions about Greek and Roman history and mythology, and one short answer question to be used in case of a tie.
- Questions will be general knowledge questions about Greek and Roman history and mythology.
- Students have 20 minutes to complete the quiz; if they finish early, they must remain in their seat, so as not to disturb the other students. When 20 minutes have elapsed, students will be told to "stop writing" and put down their pencils. Any students violating this rule will be eliminated from the competition.
- Students may NOT leave the room until the proctor announces that the quiz has ended.
- A short answer question will be asked in case of a tie.
